Province Twenty-Four
Council Minutes

March 29, 2015

A regular meeting of the Province Twenty-Four Council was held on Sunday, March 29, 2015, at 11:15 a.m., using Google Hangout, Collegiate Province Representative Kevin Lenker being in the chair and Secretary, Assistant Collegiate Province Representative Stephen Savell, being present. Also present were the Deputy Governor Andrew Owen, Cullen McBride and Kenny Oswald from Eta Phi, Tyler Griesbach and Dylan Keveryn from Lambda Xi, Cooper Haywood and Derek Johnson from Lambda Phi, Josh Rushing and Rory Young from Theta Upsilon, Elijah Thompson and Walter Hinton, Jr., from Pi Nu, and Adam Moore and Andrew O'neil Smith from the Jackson Area Alumni Association.

It was moved and seconded to forego the opening ceremony, due to the nature of the meeting space. The motion was adopted.

After the meeting agenda was approved, Deputy Governor Owen gave his officer report, indicating the nature of the meeting and that he looks forward to the coming changes.

The Province Interaction Committee gave its report, saying that interaction is on the rise and that April 13–19 would be Chapter week at Pi Nu.

The Province Financial Committee reported that chapters needed to remember to pay Province dues.

It was moved and seconded that the Province hold a Leadership Retreat at Jackson State University on August 28–30, 2015. The motion was adopted.

It was moved and seconded that the Province award \$250 to one brother per chapter or alumni

association who wins an essay competition, judged by the Deputy Governor and the Collegiate Province Representative. The motion was adopted.

It was moved and seconded that the Province add Andrew Owen and Stephen Savell to the Province Checking Account.

It was moved and seconded that the Province Interaction Committee create a Province newsletter. The motion was adopted.

It was moved and seconded that the next Province Council Meeting convene on April 26, 2015, at a time to be announced later.

It was announced that according to the Province Council Bylaws, amendments to the Province Council Bylaws must be submitted at least two weeks prior to the stated Province Council meeting.

It was announced that numbers had fallen across the Province, and that each chapter should double its efforts in recruiting in the upcoming semester and to work to maintain a healthy collegiate membership.

It was announced that Province dues are still \$8 per chapter member in good standing.

Each of the chapters and the alumni association reported future plans for the rest of the semester, including Pi Nu's Chapter Week, Theta Upsilon's event on April 4 at 1:30 p.m., Lambda Phi's plan to sing to their Chapter Sweetheart on April 20 at 7:30 p.m. in Alan Hall, Lambda Xi's plan to have an alumni luncheon on April 19 at 1 p.m. in the Band Hall, and the Alumni Association's possible events and chapter visits.

The meeting adjourned.
